
**Real Life Situation (Practice):** Socio-political issues related to the implementation of laws and/or policies The controversy related to making same-sex marriage legal.



This issue would "work" as a RLS because:

- \* it is a decision grounded in politics that eventually has a direct impact on society and the well-being of individuals in that particular context.
- \* it is highly debatable and controversial.

Possible issues to discuss in this RLS include:

- \* Who has the right to decide what is good or bad for society?
- \* How important are the needs of the individual as opposed to those of the society as a whole?
- \* What role do religion and indigenous knowledge play in the sociopolitical decisions made in some contexts?
